An increasing number of pharmacists around the country are refusing to fill prescriptions for birth-control and morning-after pills, saying that dispensing the medications violates their personal moral or religious beliefs.

Arkansas, Georgia, Mississippi and South Dakota have laws that explicitly allow pharmacists to refuse to fill prescriptions. Arizona, Texas, Arkansas, South Dakota, Georgia, Tennessee, Indiana, Rhode Island and Vermont are considering new laws allowing pharmacists to refuse to fill prescriptions. California, Illinois, Maine, Nevada, New Jersey, Washington and Wisconsin have laws that guarantee that women's birth control prescriptions will be filled.
